

## **RESOLUTION NO. 2011-01**

### **A RESOLUTION INCREASING THE MONTHLY CONTRIBUTION TO MEDICARE SUPPLEMENTAL INSURANCE THAT IS MADE BY MUNCIE SANITARY DISTRICT RETIRED EMPLOYEES**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Sanitary Commissioners (“the Board”) has heretofore established as a part of its Personnel Policy retiree supplemental health care benefits for qualifying retired employees who receive Medicare Insurance benefits; and

**WHEREAS**, as a part of providing those benefits the Board is required to establish a dollar amount that each retiree must contribute to the Muncie Sanitary District (“the District”) as their portion of the cost of such supplemental health insurance benefit, and

**WHEREAS**, the Board has determined that the contribution which is currently paid monthly by the retiree for such benefit must be incrementally increased over the next three calendar years to help offset the rising cost to the Muncie Sanitary District of such supplemental health insurance benefits.

**BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED** by the Board of Sanitary Commissioners that the amount of contribution that each retiree must pay per month for their Medicare Supplemental Benefits shall increase from Thirty Dollars (\$30.00) to Thirty Five Dollars (\$35.00) for the balance of the 2011 calendar year beginning with the March, 2011 monthly contribution due by March 1<sup>st</sup>, 2011.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Board of Sanitary Commissioners that the amount of contribution that each retiree must pay per month for their Medicare Supplemental Benefits shall increase from Thirty Five Dollars (\$35.00) to Forty Dollars (\$40.00) for the calendar year 2012.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Board of Sanitary Commissioners that the amount of contribution that each retiree must pay per month for their Medicare Supplemental Benefits shall increase from Forty Dollars (\$40.00) to Forty Five Dollars (\$45.00) for the calendar year 2013.


**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that this Resolution shall become effective on

and after its date of passage until otherwise amended or repealed by this Board.
