

**RESOLUTION No. 2012-23
OF THE
BOARD OF SANITARY COMMISSIONERS
OF THE MUNCIE SANITARY DISTRICT**

A Resolution Establishing a Revenue Funded Recycling Fund.

WHEREAS, the Board of Sanitary Commissions of the Muncie Sanitary District (the "Board") is authorized under IC 36-9-25-10(19) to act as the fiscal body of the Muncie Sanitary District (the "District"); and


WHEREAS, The Board further authorized under IC 36-9-25-10(13) to operate a service for the collection and removal of garbage and trash within the District and as a part of that process conducts programs and projects to encourage recycling of garbage and trash by the residents of the District; and

WHEREAS, The Board of Sanitary Commissioners has determined that it is necessary to establish a recycling fund for revenue income to be used for projects, demonstrations, and programs to educate the District's residents on recycling of garbage and trash and to encourage the District's residents to recycle.


NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SANITARY COMMISSIONERS OF THE MUNCIE SANITARY DISTRICT THAT:


1. A fund is hereby established for the Muncie Sanitary District a new fund to promote recycling and revenue moneys shall be allocated to that fund as directed by the Board of Sanitary Commissioners.
2. The fund shall be called the Recycling and shall be numbered as Fund No. 675.
3. The District's Financial Officer is hereby authorized to transfer from the Revenue Account No 611-90-439071 to the Recycling account, line item - Other Services and Charges – Account No 675-79-439071, the unspent funds from 2011 recycling revenues in the amount of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000.00).
4. This Resolution shall remain in full force and effect until amended or revoked by this Board.
