

RESOLUTION 2015-21

A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION 2009-05 REGARDING THE NUMBER OF TOTERS TO BE PROVIDED TO RESIDENTIAL DWELLINGS SERVICED BY THE MUNCIE SANITATION DEPARTMENT FOR USE AS SOLID WASTE CONTAINERS.

WHEREAS, the Muncie Sanitary District has previously passed on April 7, 2009, RESOLUTION 2009-05 a Resolution relating to solid waste collected by the District; and

WHEREAS, said RESOLUTION 2009-05 in part established the number of solid waste containers ("toters") to be provided by the Muncie Sanitary District to each dwelling serviced by the District; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Sanitary Commissioners wishes to amend RESOLUTION 2009-05 to decrease the number of toters provided to multi family units as a service to its residential customers; and


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of the Sanitary Commissioners of the Muncie Sanitary District that:

Section 5 C.), Toters be amended to read as follows:


"For regular solid waste pick-up service by the Sanitation Department, each single family dwelling, multi family dwelling containing four (4) or fewer living units and each non-dwelling unit shall have no more than two (2) 96 gallon and/or 64 gallon Toters unless additional Toters are leased through the Muncie Sanitary District for an additional fee of \$5.00 per month each (or the then existing additional fee as it may from time to time be established by Resolution of the Board of Sanitary Commissioners). Accessory structures and vacant lots shall not be entitled to Toters."

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SANITARY COMMISSIONERS OF THE MUNCIE SANITARY DISTRICT that this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Board of Sanitary Commissioners.


