RESOLUTION NO. 2025- 14**

**RESOLUTION APPROVING SALE OF SURPLUS PERSONAL PROPERTY TO
DELAWARE COUNTY, INDIANA**

WHEREAS, the Board of Sanitary Commissioners, as the governing body of the Muncie Sanitary District (the “District”), has determined that it is in the best interest of the District to dispose of surplus personal property, namely two trucks as more specifically described below; and

WHEREAS, Delaware County, Indiana (the “County”), by and through its Board of Commissioners, has indicated its interest in purchasing said surplus personal property from the District; and

WHEREAS, Ind. Code § 5-22-22-10 allows the MSD to make a sale to another governmental entity of its surplus personal property upon any terms and conditions agreed to by the parties in substantially similar resolutions;

WHEREAS, the Board of Sanitary Commissioners now desires to declare the following property to be surplus and sell those items to the County for the values set forth below, payable in one lump sum on or before forty-five (45) days from the last of the two resolutions’ approval.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Sanitary Commissioners of the Muncie Sanitary District, Delaware County, State of Indiana, that:

1. The following items of personal property are hereby declared to be surplus and eligible for sale by the District:
